

CONNECTED TO BC HYDRO POWER GRID, SAVE MONEY WITH NET METERING

Grid Tie Systems are your own power plant. They provide a portion or all of your electricity and are a good investment to offset your electrical costs.

Batteries are not required for these systems. Electricity generated by solar is first used on site with the excess sent back to BC Hydro. The utility acts as your storage as you earn energy credits for electricity fed back to the grid.

If there is a power outage, the solar system shuts down to prevent back-feeding electricity to the disabled grid. Contact Viridian if you would like to know more about backup power systems.

IF YOU ARE HAVING A NEW HOME BUILT:

- Tip 1 → Ensure you have good south facing roof space clear of shading.
- Tip 2 → Have the roof structure designed for the additional load of solar panels.
- Tip 3 → Have your home prewired for the solar.
